CEO REPORT

<u>60th Anniversary</u>

The German-Canadian Benevolent Society of BC was incorporated on April 1, 1965. The founding members had a vision, to build a home for German-speaking seniors' where they will receive support as they age and are able to live with others who share their history, culture and language. A home for seniors of the German-Canadian community in BC. This year, as we are looking back on the past 60 years, we celebrate the realization of the dream of the founding members, the resilience of the Society, and the organization's ability to continuously adapt to a changing environment.

This diamond anniversary will be celebrated with an Oktoberfest-themed event on Thursday, 25 September 2025. The planning of this party is underway, and we will share more information at the Annual General Meeting in June.

A team of staff and Board Members are working on a commemorative book that narrates the story of the Society with photos, information and anecdotes. This book will be available in both hardcover and online format.

<u>Moving forward</u>

During the past few years, the Society has been undergoing a transformation that started with planning for a redevelopment of the physical structures, the buildings that have lovingly been maintained and renovated over the past 56 years and have been home to many seniors who received care and compassion at this stage of their lives. The redevelopment of the physical buildings was initiated because the existing buildings are no longer adequate for providing long-term care to residents with complex care needs. The Society's Board and leadership have been working towards a new, state-of-the-art building and we are now very close to making it a reality.

The second element of the transformation is a change of our care model, moving from a medical, institutional model to a social and resident-directed model that we have named Comfortzeit[®]. We trademarked the name and are passionate about fully implementing this innovative approach to seniors' care in the coming years.

The third, and equally important aspect ensuring the Society's future, is addressing the generational change that is taking place within the Society's community. The Society will need to build a new community of supporters, a community of people who see the work of our Society as meaningful and as something that is worthwhile of their support.

I look forward to welcoming you to our Annual General Meeting in June where we will report on the progress made thus far and our plans for a successful future of the German-Canadian Benevolent Society of BC.
